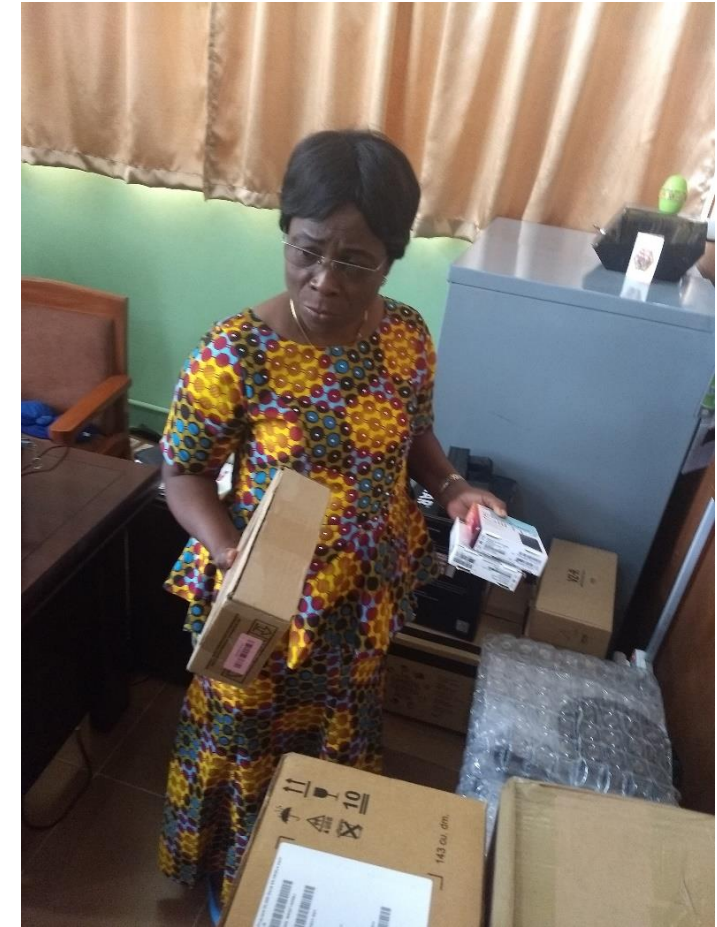

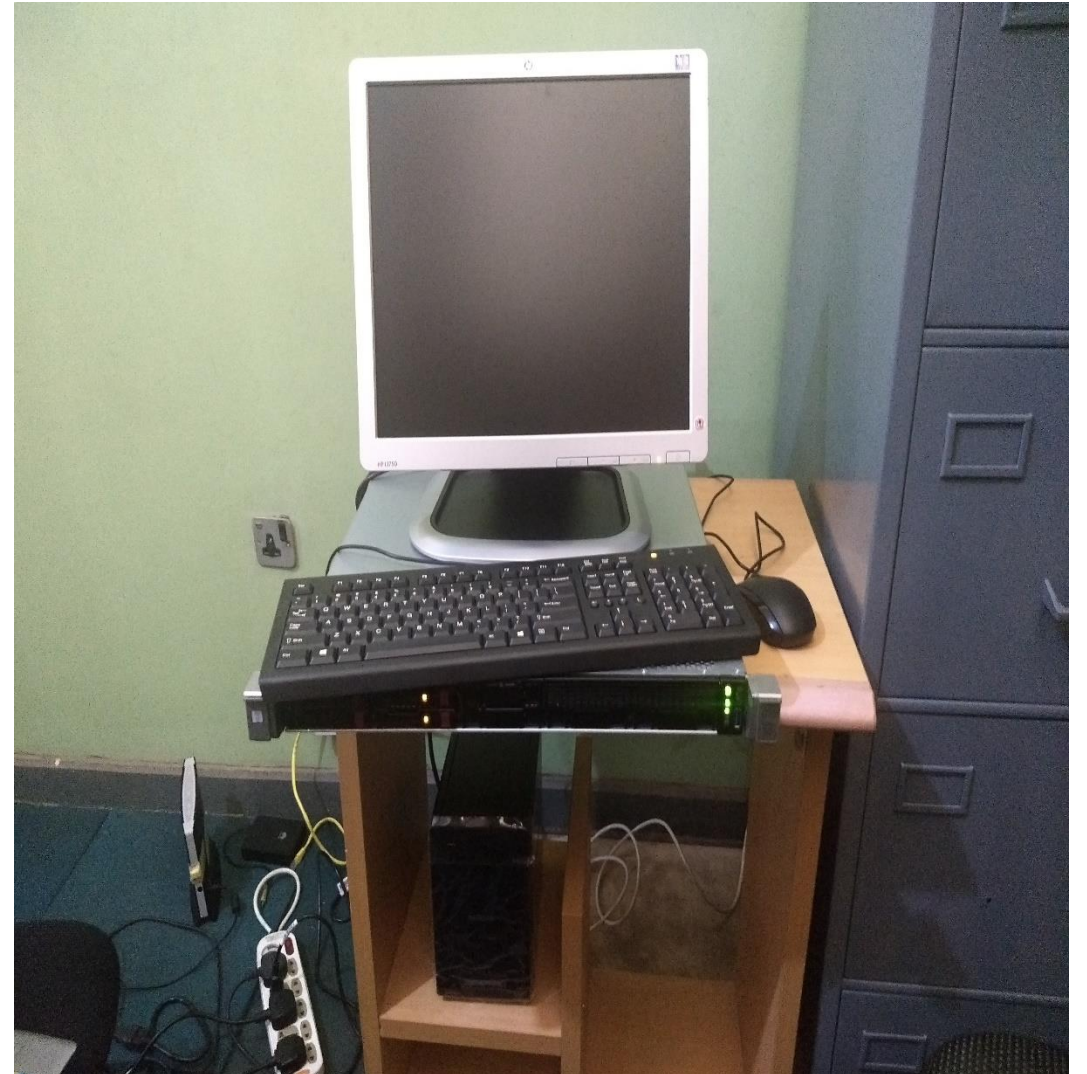
Digital Repository Policy

- At the University of Ibadan, we have a draft IR policy
- The UL inaugurated an IR Policy Development Committee
- The committee consisted of six librarians
- Members were charged with developing an IR policy for the University
- The committee came up with a draft policy
- The draft was sent out by UL to other stake holders for input and eventually submitted to the DVC (Research, Innovation and Strategic Partnership)
- University management set up an Ad hoc committee to review it
- The final draft of the policy by the University Ad hoc Committee is awaiting approval and adoption by the University

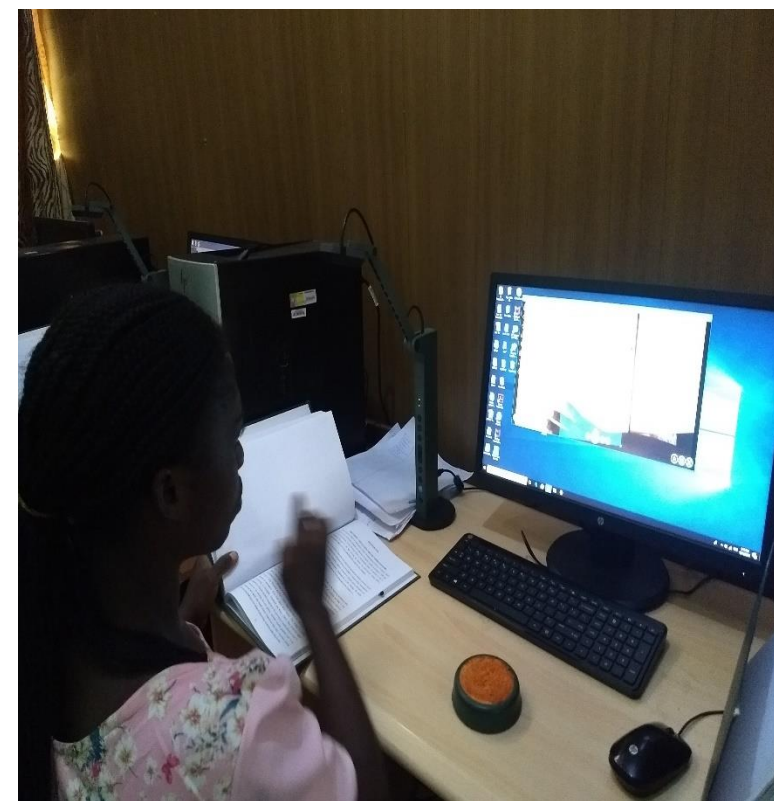
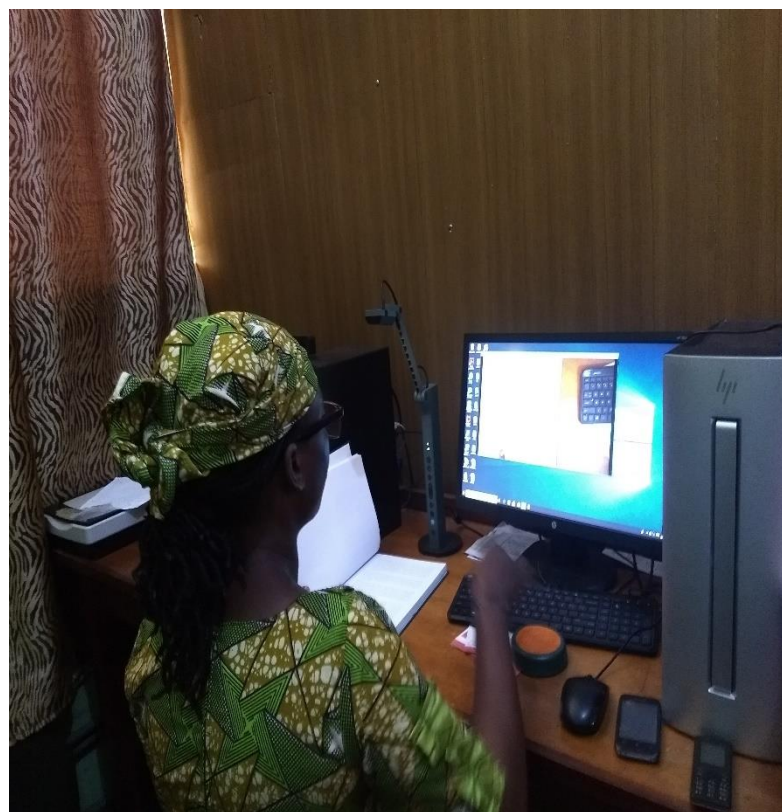
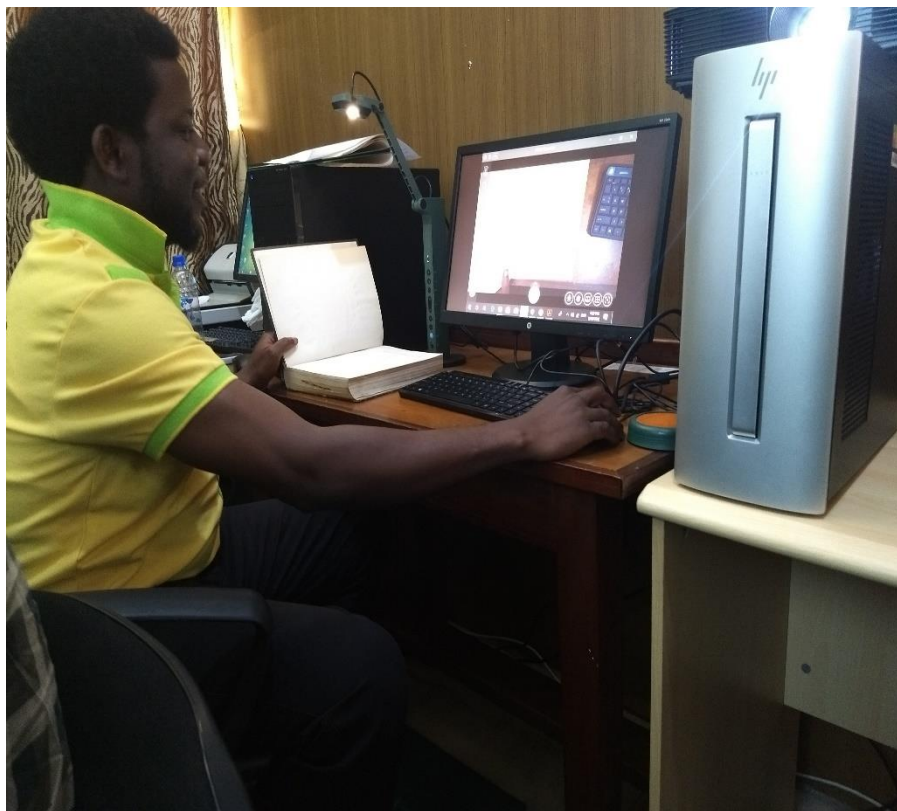

CURRENT STATUS OF ADHL-UI REPOSITORY

- Creation of communities and sub-communities
- Main communities: Faculties in the College of Medicine
- Sub-communities: Departments and institutes in the College
- A total of 250 theses and dissertations have been scanned
- Of this number, 160 theses have been added to the repository
- This consists of 97 theses and 54 dissertation
