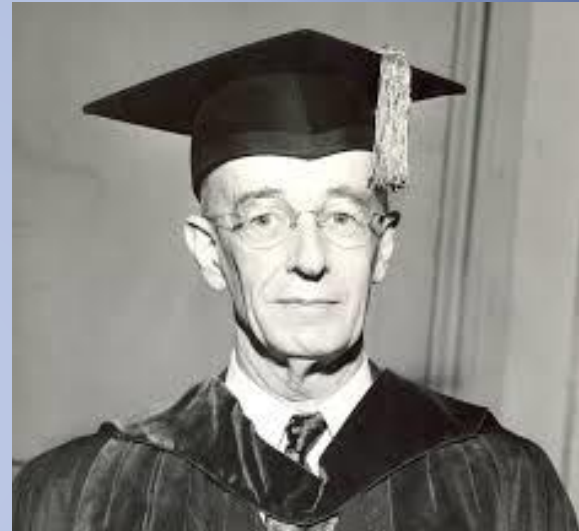


Current debates

- Lancet Repositioning Africa in global knowledge production

 - *Except for Kenya and Uganda, research teams in many parliaments are thinly staffed and therefore unable to meet the evidence demand in the parliaments.*

 - 4 African University Institutional Repositories
 - PhD Theses
 - Cancer
 - No time limit
 - No language limit
- Exclusion criteria
 - Non-Doctoral Theses and Dissertations
 - Veterinary Theses

Search of Institutional Repositories

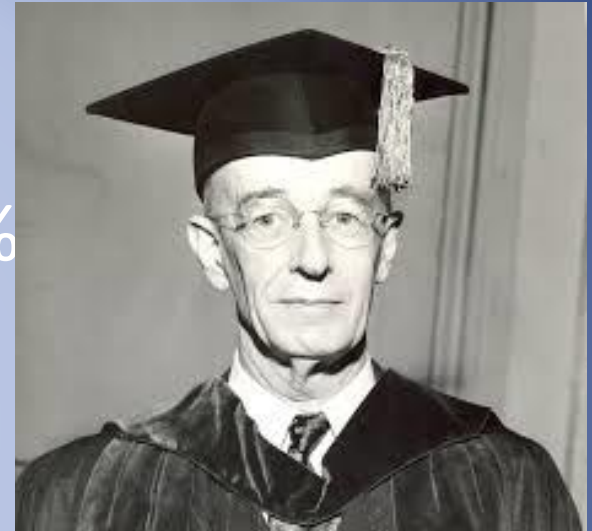
- African Universities Institutional Repositories
 - Ghana, Kenya, Nigeria, South Africa
- Apply Inclusion Criteria
- Check Institutional Repositories for access to PDF
- Check Google Scholar for PDFs and citations
- Search for publications arising from theses

The Bush Test Report Card

1. Is it accessible ? 100%
2. Has it been stored ? 74-100%
3. Has it been consulted ?
72% (34) published
53% (25) cited



Observations

- Many countries in Africa have an artificially low Global research profile
- Digitized records of dissertations are accessible, but the repositories are not widely known
- Coverage is patchy and access frustrated by vulnerable links, firewalls, slow speed
- 9 IR PDFs have been cited by other authors. The only way this could have happened is through digitization.

Living in the Digital World

- U of N: robust infrastructure for digitization
- Different stages of development
- External vulnerabilities – e.g. Power outages, virus attacks, slow Internet speed, ForEx
- Concern about Sustainability “when the project ends...”
- Need for teamwork beyond silos

UNIVERSAL HEALTH COVERAGE

The universal and equitable provision, for free or at low cost at point of delivery, of those forms of health care that have been shown through proper evaluation to be effective.

UHC means Digitization

- Given that UHC is on the table, what type of National Information Strategy is needed?
- Increased importance of accessing high quality domestic and regional health research
- Digitization is a necessary process
- Improve access to contextually relevant high quality information, for Policymakers, Researchers, Businesses, Practitioners and Patients

What could be done?

- Unite with others to press for National Information Strategies to inform UHC
- Organise a Regional UHC-D Meeting 2019
- Essential University infrastructure for digitization
- Ensuring that the links operate 24/7

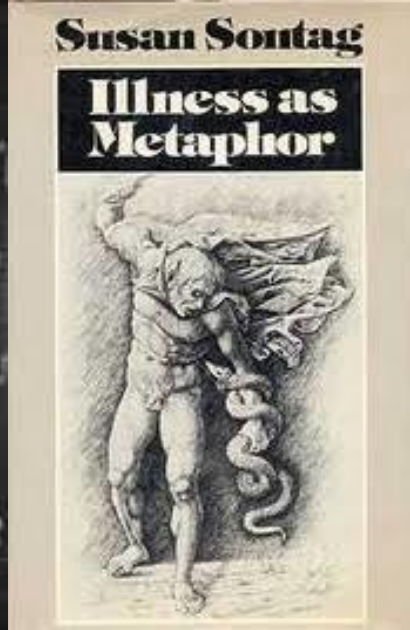
